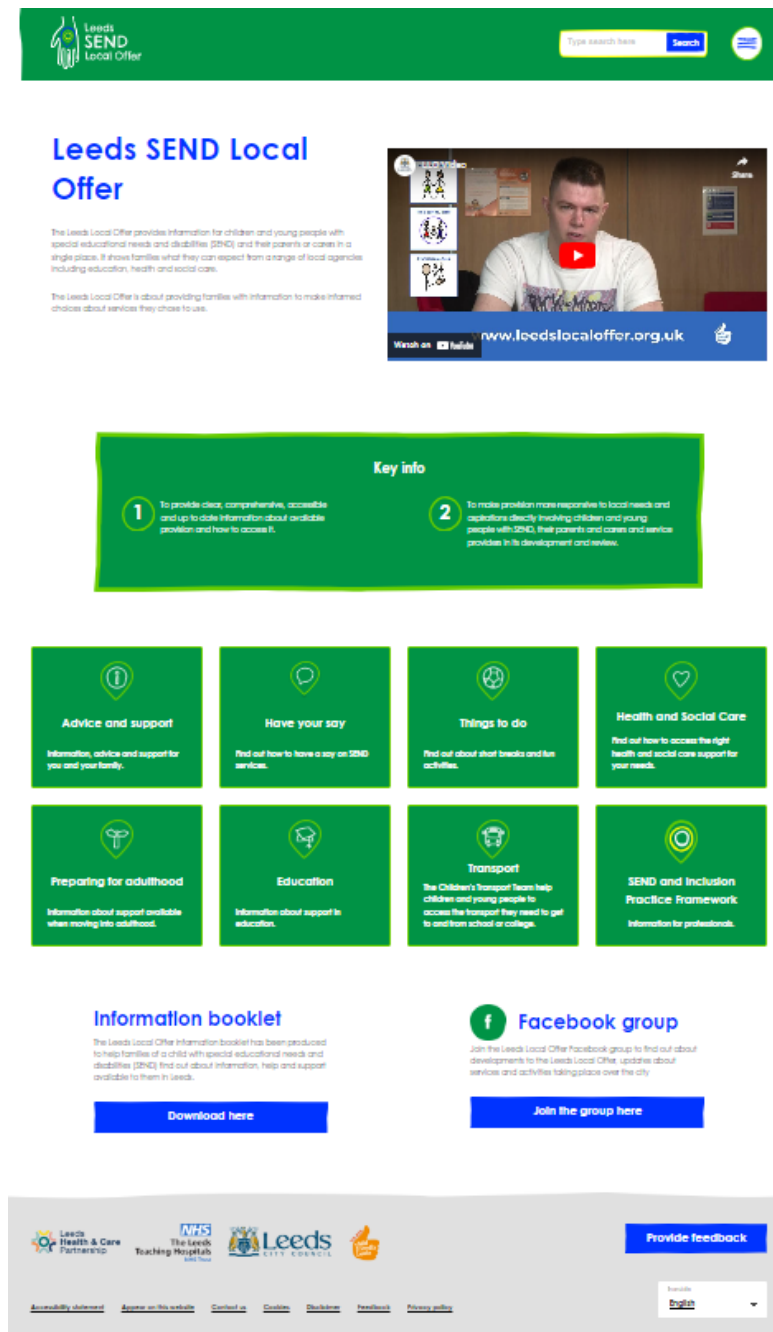
The Leeds Local Offer has two key purposes;
